

Prom Dress Code

As prom season draws near, please keep in mind the following rules:

AGE:

- Your date must be at least a 9th grader (all attendees must be enrolled in school, have a diploma, working on a GED or have GED).
- Your date cannot equal or be older than age 21.

DRESS CODE: REMEMBER—it is your job to share these rules with your date if they are not a student here at PCHS.

- Any visible piercing other than the ear or nose will be prohibited. Nose rings must be approved by the Principal or designee.
- Tuxedo coats may be removed, but the dress shirts cannot be unbuttoned (other than at the collar) or removed
- Students may not wear hats that are not considered formal wear.
- No one may wear sunglasses during grand march.
- Prom dresses should not be shorter than 2 inches above the knee.
- Prom dresses should not have a slit that extends higher than 2 inches above the knee.
- Dresses cannot have any cutouts that reveal skin on the front or sides of the dress, nor can they have sheer, skin-toned fabric that gives the illusion that bare skin is showing.
- Dresses cannot show bare skin below the waistline in the back.
- Dresses cannot be too revealing. Example-cut too low in front.

A picture of you in your dress must be turned in to Libby no later than Monday April 4th in order to be eligible for prom. Pictures must show front, back, sides, and length of dress and must be printed out and will be kept on file in a locked cabinet in Libby's office.
